2024 U.S. Federal Elections: The Insider Threat

The Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA), the Federal Bureau of Investigation's (FBI) Counterintelligence, Criminal, and Cyber Divisions, in coordination with the FBI's Office of Private Sector, the Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) Office of Intelligence and Analysis (I&A), and the U.S. Election Assistance Commission (EAC), released a resource to help partners to defend against insider threat concerns that could materialize during the 2024 election cycle.

Applications Open for New \$20 Million Program

Pennsylvania Broadband Development Authority (PBDA) Executive Director Brandon Carson announced the opening of the Digital Connectivity Technology Program application period from June 20 to August 19, 2024.

The program will distribute \$20 million in laptops to libraries, municipalities, workforce training organizations, and other community institutions in areas where broadband affordability is a barrier. Applications can be submitted online via the **PBDA website**.

The PBDA will review applications starting August 20, with grant awards expected in November. Projects will commence in early 2025. Grant recipients must offer digital skills training, although participation for end users is optional.

This initiative, funded by the American Rescue Plan Capital Projects, aims to bridge the digital divide for 286,000 households, businesses, schools, and libraries in Pennsylvania lacking sufficient broadband access. Additionally, Pennsylvania will receive over \$1.16 billion from the federal BEAD Program to expand broadband in underserved areas.

Further investments include \$204 million from the Capital Projects Fund for Broadband Infrastructure and \$45 million for community facility improvements.

These efforts support the Shapiro Administration's goal of ensuring that all Pennsylvanians have access to high-speed internet for education, business, and healthcare.

Efficiency (MORE)

The Pennsylvania Energy Development Authority is launching the MORE Program under the Energy Accelerator Program, offering grants and loans to municipal governments (counties, towns, cities, townships, authorities, and boroughs) not eligible for an Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG).

We strongly encourage all eligible entities to apply and use this opportunity to boost their energy efficiency projects.
