The Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA), the Federal Bureau of Investigation's (FBI) Counterintelligence, Criminal, and Cyber Divisions, in coordination with the FBI's Office of Private Sector, the Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) Office of Intelligence and Analysis (I&A), and the U.S. Election Assistance Commission (EAC), released a resource to help partners to defend against insider threat concerns that could materialize during the 2024 election cycle.

CCAP's Center for Excellence in County Leadership professional development program graduated 10 county leaders from its two-and-a-half-day intensive training program.

The CEL program enhances personal growth through interactive executive training focused on improving communication, management, and leadership skills. It includes intensive courses in leadership styles, managerial flexibility, interpersonal dynamics, strategic planning, media management, daily communication problem-solving, and decision-making.

An application is required for admittance to the program, and the CCAP Education Committee makes the final selection. The program is open to county commissioners or council members, chief clerks, county administrators, solicitors, and other key departmental leaders within Pennsylvania's 67 counties. Dering Consulting Group (www.deringconsulting.com) produced the 2024 CEL program.
