State Funds are Now Available from the PCCD

Indigent Defense Grant Program

The Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD) has announced that state funds are available to support the FY 2023-24 Indigent Defense Grant Program.

This grant program aims to enhance indigent defense services in Pennsylvania by bolstering staff recruitment and retention, upgrading data collection and reporting capabilities, providing essential training and professional development, and addressing identified gaps in consultation with county and service provider input.

All counties are eligible for this non-competitive grant. PCCD expects to fund up to 67 grants; further details can be found in the **Funding Announcement Title**. You must be registered with **PCCD** to access the system.

2024 County Jail-Based Vivitrol Program

PCCD has announced the availability of Act 80 funding in the **2024 County Jail-Based Vivitrol Program**.

This is a **non-competitive grant** open to all 62 counties with a county jail. Each county's allocation for this two year funding period can be found in the attachment at the end of the funding announcement.

Applications are due July 17, 2024, for a two-year grant period of October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2026.

2024 County Reentry Strategic Planning Grants Available

The Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD) has announced the availability of \$150,000 for 2024 County Reentry Strategic Planning Grants. PCCD expects to fund 10 grants with budgets not exceeding \$15,000 over the 12-month project period. Details are **here**.

County governments and non-profit organizations that convene a County Reentry Coalition are eligible for these funds. The 2024 County Reentry Strategic Planning grants aim to encourage County Reentry Coalitions to create or update reentry strategic plans using the community collaborative approach. Applications from counties without a reentry strategic plan will receive priority consideration. Counties with an existing reentry strategic plan may apply for funding to update their plan.

DCTI to Increase Access to Affordable Devices

The Digital Connectivity Technology Initiative (DCTI), supported by the Coronavirus Capital Projects Fund, aims to enhance access to technology devices in areas where affordability challenges broadband adoption and utilization.

The Pennsylvania Broadband Development Authority (PBDA) is set to allocate \$20,000,000 in devices through a competitive grant process, targeting public-facing community anchor institutions and local government entities. To learn more about the program, click the link provided below.
