Grant Opportunities Now Open in PCCD Egrants System

The Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD) has announced that state funds are available to support the FY 2023-24 Indigent Defense Grant Program.

This grant program aims to enhance indigent defense services in Pennsylvania by bolstering staff recruitment and retention, upgrading data collection and reporting capabilities, providing essential training and professional development, and addressing identified gaps in consultation with county and service provider input.

All counties are eligible for this non-competitive grant. PCCD expects to fund up to 67 grants; further details can be found in the **Funding Announcement Title**. You must be registered with **PCCD** to access the system.

CCAP encourages you to acknowledge those who have made a difference in county government this past year in the lives of Pennsylvanians.


