Sgt. Ollis of Coatesville Police and Tpr. Gonzalez from the Embreeville State Police Barracks, provide invaluable educational programming for the youth at our center in Detention and our Shelter programs. Establishing relationships with Chester County officers is key for when our residents return home. This unconventional program has done wonders to break down stereotypes and misconceptions about police officers in Chester County. Hard questions and thought provoking discussion; questions about the officers involved in their cases, it speaks to Disproportionate Minority Contact (DMC) as many kids ask why cops only lock up "black kids," and lastly, when Sgt. Ollis or Trooper Gonzalez have been involved in "locking up" our residents family members and friends as the arresting officer. Genuine answers are given from a police prospective but also since both officers are parents; they allow some vulnerability to explain their positions as a parent as well and living in a safe community. Our youth now have a formed relationship and ally in their home community upon release, which is the greatest benefit of this program.

Roger often says, "They don't care how much you know, until they know how much you care." The theme of the "hot seat" sessions is that Education is important, make quality decisions, care about your community and stay safe. Both officers give their time without asking for anything in return and make themselves available to all of our youth even at the programs conclusion to speak in private. Their mentoring roles and relationships formed at the center with residents and staffs are irreplaceable.


